Lower Treginnis farm sits in a stunningly beautiful location on the Pembrokeshire coast. As well as farm tasks, you'll have the chance to spot seals, porpoises and sea birds along the coastal path as well as sampling our local, unspoiled beaches.

To help you immerse yourself in the beauty of your surroundings, we aim to minimise digital distractions with no TVs on site and no phones out on the farm.



All activities on the farm will be fully supervised by our knowledgeable and experienced staff, and we provide all training, tools, equipment and protective clothing.

Two members of our team stay onsite overnight in case of an out-of-hours emergency, and during the day there will be a team of our staff around to guide and support.

This summer, as well as farm tasks and general maintenance, participants will be helping us rebuild our much-loved 'goat playground', sadly destroyed by winter storms in December.

There is a mix of accommodation, but typically 4-8 bunk dorms with their own shower rooms. A multi faith prayer space is available.

The residential is full board - we provide delicious, freshly prepared meals which you will be involved in preparing, cooking and other kitchen duties (washing up!).

Please note transport is not provided, however we can arrange collections from St David's and Haverfordwest at a designated time, if requested.
